The school will provide Classical Education in the form of *The Trivium*, with the future plan to implement the *Catechesis of the Good Shepherd* as further enrichment ministry to the children. These learning experiences will be presented in a context compliant with the Australian Curriculum, as required by all Victorian schools.



Our Lady of Fatima Classical School seeks to engage the gifts of a passionate and professional educator to cultivate truth, goodness and beauty in children, through the Catholic Tradition and Classical Education pedagogy.

The successful candidate will be of a living faith, of whose love and devotion to God and the furthering of the Catholic Tradition is evident. Our Lady of Fatima Classical School holds the expectation of the appointed Classroom Teacher's participation in Linton Parish's life and liturgy. The candidate will hold full registration with the VIT.

While experience in the Classical Education model of *The Trivium* would be ideal, it is not essential. However, knowledge of Classical Education methods of teaching and learning, understanding Classical Education's aims, and a willingness to grow in Professional Knowledge, Practise and Engagement in *The Trivium*, are fundamental.

As we embark on this journey to establish a new school, working with The Board, the Principal and all school staff to cultivate and communicate the school's vision and expectations in a clear and inspiring way, will be imperative. The ability to communicate peacefully and effectively with the different members of the school community will be essential.

Leading by example, the Classroom Teacher will be patient, kind and fair. Living faith and cultivating virtues will be the primary aim of the educator. Respecting Parents as first educators, working with the Principal to create unity between home, school and the Church will be central to the role.

The ability to engage children with Scripture and to nurture children's prayer life is a vital aspect of the role. OLFCS will be offering children Classical Education through Individual Learning Plans in multi age groupings. Experience in these areas would be advantageous.
